

CES Guidelines

- *CES 1-800-639-9002 (all IPRA rodeos call this number to enter).
- *Information should be given in the following order: rodeo, event, performance, card number, or social security number if you're a local.
- *You will receive a confirmation number for "confirmed entries" or "draw outs". All calls are recorded. You should keep this number; you will need it if there is a problem with your entry.
- *Full card holders will have priority in entering over permits, youth cards, and locals. It will be the responsibility of all entries who are not card holders to check back with CES to verify whether his/her entry has been accepted for the performance requested.
- *At first come, first serve rodeos (\$999. adm or less) when entering a rodeo and a given performance is full, a waiting list will be formed on a first come, first serve basis for that performance. When other performances are full, CES will use the waiting list and the contestant will be responsible for verifying whether his/her entry has been accepted. No waiting list entries will be confirmed until two (2) hours prior to books closing.
- *All rodeos adding \$1,000. or more per event will open on Wednesday or Thursday of the week prior to the rodeo and will draw for performances with option to trade out.
- *A contestant working two or more one go-round events in a single rodeo that draws for positions (regardless of whether the rodeo trades out or not) may request that he/she compete in all events during the day that is first drawn for him in a single event. If a two (2) or more event contestant is taken in one (1) event, contestant must be taken in all events entered in the same performance.
- *There will be no drawing out after the books close. You can only draw out at least 3 hours prior to books closing.
- *Members will be able to notify turn-outs three (3) hours or more prior to the start of the rodeo performance, 1-800-639-9002 (time frame will be in the time zone in which the rodeo is being held).
- *If you pay entry fees at the time you notify turn-out there will not be a turn out fee and this money will be added into the payoff.
- *If you notify turn-out and do not pay your entry fees at that time the turn-out fee will be \$25.00.
- *If you turn-out and do not notify, then the turn-out fee will be \$50.00.
